2020 Preservation Grants

Salem Academy and College Archives, Gramley Library

Granted: \$900

The goal of the grant is to cover the preservation assessment of the collection and its environment, using the resulting report to apply for other grants, such as the NEH Preservation Assistance Grant for Smaller Institutions.

Greensboro History Museum

Granted: \$786

The goal of the grant is to place 13 watercolor paintings in window mats for protection. This grant will cover part of the costs of this project.

Pope House Museum

Granted: \$2,000

The goal of the grant is to pay for conservation of a diploma and its frame, as well as a digital scan of the diploma.

Asheville Art Museum

Granted: \$943

The goal of the grant is to rehouse a large collection of silver, using Pacific silvercloth zipper bags and storage pouches placed in boxes. The grant covers the cost of all bags and pouches for this project.
